1. Before upgrading WEBCON BPS

1.1. Before upgrading WEBCON BPS

- To avoid interruptions in the system operation, make sure that WEBCON BPS licenses are up to date. To do this, verify the availability of the **WEBCON BPS Server 2021** license in the license report. This report is available from **WEBCON BPS Designer Studio -> system menu in the upper left corner -> Licenses**. Current licenses must be downloaded if necessary.
- If the changelog contains a section titled "Changes to existing features", please verify whether the changes will impact your implemented system in any way.

1.2. General

- Please remember that **WEBCON BPS Authorization Service** (auth.webconbps.com) will be retired by the end of 2023. Users that have **WEBCON BPS Authorization Service** configured in their system should consider switching to other authentication providers.

The system's built-in authentication providers (OpenID Connect or ADFS) should be used instead of **WEBCON BPS Authorization Service**.

2. Bug fixes

2.1. Form

- Fixed an issue with the performance of **Choice fields** in **Autocomplete** mode.

2.2. Actions

- Fixed an issue with signing PDF attachments in Adobe with IT Hit Edit Doc Opener.
- When using **Business rules** for value mapping in the configuration of **Invoke REST Web service** actions the action will now correctly save the type of data returned by the rule.

2.3. Service

- Enhanced handling of queues and optimized SQL queries in **WEBCON Workflow Service**. The changes affect the operation of queues without interrupting them in the event of slow SQL query execution.
- The following changes have been made to the synchronization of BPS users: - Fixed an error where deleting a user and synchronizing a single user in AD would remove group membership of their subordinates - Fixed an error where changing the user's NetBios login in AD and user incremental synchronization in BPS resulted in duplicate users in the system - Changed the order of incremental synchronization and single user steps in AD and ADD

2.4. Security fixes

- Fixed an issue in WEBCON BPS Portal that made it possible to access documents of other users with administrator privileges.
