1. Before upgrading WEBCON BPS

1.1. Before upgrading WEBCON BPS

- To avoid unnecessary interruptions in the system operation, make sure that WEBCON BPS licenses are up to date. To do this, verify the availability of the **WEBCON BPS Server 2021** license in the license report. This report is available from **WEBCON BPS Designer Studio** -> *system menu in the upper left corner* -> **Licenses**. Current licenses must be downloaded if necessary.
- If the changelog contains a section titled "Changes to existing features", please verify whether the changes will impact your implemented system in any way.

2. Information

2.1. Security fixes

- Upgrade of moment.js to version (2.29.4) due to vulnerabilities: CVE-2022-31129 and CWE-1333

3. Bug fixes

3.1. General

- Fixed an issue where .xml logs were downloaded to the import history only after clicking on the change history preview or export to file.
- Fixed an issue with migration scripts 5416 and 6116.
- For new installations, the isCSRFCheckEnabled parameter should be set to **false** by default. Having it set to **"0"** would block access to Portal.

3.2. Portal

- Fixed an issue that occurred when attempting to edit a substitution created for a process/business entity after the option to define a substitution per process/business entity is deactivated in the substitution configuration.

3.3. Form

- Using **Form rules** to affect an **Item list** that is set to not visible in the **Field matrix** will now display a warning instead of an error.

3.4. Designer Studio

- Improved the efficiency of HotMailBoxes that use Microsoft Graph Authentication - installation with a large number of configured HotMailBoxes would sometimes encounter the "Application is over its MailboxConcurrency limit" error.

3.5. Data sources

- Added a validation mechanism to the installer that will check that for each superior source, each business entity has no more than one subordinate data source.
